4-H/FFA steers must weigh in by 2:00 pm.

Rules:

1. Stall space may not be reserved; owner and animal must be present. Stalls are available on first come, first serve basis.
2. Animals must be registered in owner's name.
3. Registration papers must be presented at time of entry on all classes.
4. Where there is only one exhibitor in the class the first prize, if merited, will be awarded. Where there is competition all prizes may be awarded so far as there are worthy entries. Where animals are not worthy of first prize judges may at their discretion, award a prize or prizes of such grade as the animals deserve.
5. All exhibitors are limited to winning two premium and two ribbons in each class and only one prize in group classes.
6. All animals exhibited must meet state health regulations governing beef show. Refer to health requirements elsewhere in the Fair Book.
7. Fat steers and heifers classes will be determined by an out of county committee. All decisions will be final.
8. 4-H/FFA Commercial heifers are not to exceed two years of age.
9. Heifers that show in breeding classes cannot show in fat steer and heifer classes.
10. If a weight class is too large for the comfort of the judge, it will be broken by lottery.

If 4-H/FFA Grand Champion is Grant County bred and owned they will receive \$100.00. If 4-H/FFA Reserve Grand Champion is Grant County bred and owned they will receive \$50.00. This incentive is sponsored by the Grant County Cattleman's Association.

Feeder Calf Rules

1. Feeder calves can be steers or heifers; animals cannot have horns or scurs. Steer must be castrated by tagging date determined by 4H agent
2. Calves must originate from a herd in Grant County. A buyer-seller agreement form will be filled out and turned in at weigh-in.
3. Feeder calves must be weaned 30 day prior to the first day of the fair.
4. Feeder calves must be owned by tagging date determined by 4H agent. Calves must be in possession of the youth exhibitors by July 1, 2008.
5. Calves may be any beef breed or beef crossbred.
6. Calves must be born January 1 – March 31, 2008.
7. At fair time calves must weigh a minimum of 300 pounds and a maximum of 650 pounds.
No Exceptions.
8. Feeder calves are to be tagged in on May 12, the same day as hogs and lambs. Entry fee is \$20 per head.
9. Pre-conditioning shots may be given by May 12, 2008 at weigh in.
10. The youth feeder calf show will follow the steer show. Classes will be determined by weight. Steer and heifer will show together.
11. Calves will be shown by halter
12. Feeder calves must be on the fairgrounds by 10 AM. On Friday August 4, 2008. Weigh in will follow finished steers.
13. 4H member must complete the 6 hour meeting requirement prior to tagging in animals.

I understand the rules stated above and agree to abide by them.
