Rules:

1. Purebreds and Americans will be shown in purebred classes (bring registration papers).
2. Recorded grades must show registration papers also.
3. All goats must have current health papers.
4. Horns must be tipped. The end of the horn must be no larger than ½ inch.
5. No bucks allowed on the fairgrounds.
6. Base date for determining age is date of show.
7. Show starts promptly at 11:30 am. Goats must be entered by 11:00 am. (no entry fees)
8. Youth ages 8 and under may show as cloverbuds. A ribbon will be awarded but no premiums will be given.
9. All 4-H and FFA members must have ownership of their animal by June 1 of the current year.

- 14 Dry Yearling (born 8-10-05 – 8-18-06)
- 15 Junior Champ (Grant County 4-H/FFA class winner from classes 11-14) plaque only
- 16 Junior Champ (Open class winner from classes 11 – 14) – Trophy only

Classes: Dairy – Senior Does

The **Senior Does** are 24 months of age or over, that have never been freshened or are in milk. This also includes the Dry Milkers.

- 17 Yearling & 2 yr old milker
- 18 3 & 4 yr old milker
- 19 5 yr old & over milker
- 20 Senior Champ (Grant County 4-H/FFA class winner from classes 17-19) – Plaque only
- 21 Senior Champ (Open class winner from classes 17-19) – Trophy only
- 22 Supreme Champion (4-H/FFA Junior Champ & Senior Champ) – Banner only
- 23 Reserve Supreme Champion (4-H/FFA Junior Champ & Senior Champ) – Plaque only
